During the first quarter of this year Argosy actively investigated a number of opportunities in Africa. This subsequently resulted in the Company entering into agreements to acquire two highly prospective exploration areas for graphite in Namibia, as announced on 30 April 2013.

Argosy has not progressed any further with the acquisition of its two coal prospects in the KwaZulu Natal region of South Africa.

Therefore, immediate activities will now be focused on the newly announced Graphite project.
